<p>Overall</p> <p>The aforementioned position will be responsible, and expected to carry out the below indicative, and not limited, activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drive the Project lifecycle from Limited Notice to Proceed (LNTP) to Commercial Operation Date • Manage all Project’s agreements (such as PPA, NCC, EPC, O&M, OE, IE, MSA, etc.), consulting agreements, special licensing and other agreements that are relevant to the construction of the power plant • Manage, plan, organize, coordinate and control the Project implementation process, and be responsible for achieving the contractual Project’s targets • Responsible to ensure the Project is executed properly in terms of quality, schedule, and budget, in line with the EPC Contract and the Project’s requirements in general, and the Good Engineering and Constructions Practices, without lost time accidents, severe injuries and/or fatalities • Monitoring and reporting to the Board of Directors, the Project construction progress and anticipate/highlight potential issues that can arise and affect the Project construction, and propose solutions • Establish and maintain the necessary processes to manage the scope over the project lifecycle, setting Project’s quality and performance standards, and assessing and managing the risks • Manage the Project’s budget with maximum efforts for cost reduction/optimization • Responsible for contract negotiations, change orders, claims and other agreements with the EPC Contractor, with the support from the Project team, including the Contracts Manager
